INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

WORKMANSHIP: All work shall be completed in a first-class workmanlike manner. The City may perform random inspections of the site, and the contractor will guarantee all materials and workmanship for a period of one (1) year.

SUPERVISION: The contractor shall have in charge of the work at all times during construction, a thoroughly competent supervisor. Anyone not deemed capable by the Owner shall be replaced immediately upon request by someone who is satisfactory.

LABOR, MATERIALS & EQUIPMENT: The contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, tools, scaffolds, and other equipment necessary to properly complete the work according to the specifications, as well as any safety devices the contractor deems necessary for safe operations, or as required by law.

INSURANCE: The contractor shall not commence, nor allow a sub-contractor to commence, work under this contract until he has obtained all insurance required under this heading and such insurance has been approved by the owner.

1. Workmen's Compensation Insurance as required by Michigan Workmen's Compensation Laws.
2. Contractor's Public Liability Insurance shall be furnished for \$25,000 limits for injuries to any one person and \$50,000 for any one accident.
3. Contractor's Property Damage Insurance shall be furnished for \$5,000 limits for damages as a result of any one accident and \$10,000 limits as an aggregate

All policies required shall be written by a company licensed to do business in the State of Michigan. The City shall be named as an additional named insured on all liability policies.

The Contractor shall notify the City immediately of any damages in the project site, whether or not the contractor is liable.

MEASUREMENT & PAYMENT: Contractor will invoice the City after all bacti samples have been completed and the well is approved by the MDEQ to be placed back into service. The City pays on the 10th and 25th of each month, the contractor must have the final invoice turned in 3 days prior to the 10th or 25th.

EQUIPMENT: The Contractor shall furnish all equipment required to perform the work in the attached specifications and any safety devices the contractor feels necessary for safe operations, or as required by law.

LICENSING & PERMITS: The contractor shall comply with all local, state and federal regulations and statutes.

PROPOSALS: All bids must be submitted on the attached bid form and received in the Office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 411 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838, on or before **Tuesday, February 21st, 2017 at 2:30 p.m.**

BID ENVELOPE LABELING: Please mark **WELL #6 REPAIRS** on the outside of the envelope and submit to the City Clerk's Office prior to the bid opening.

RIGHTS RESERVED BY THE OWNER: The City of Greenville reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids. The competency and responsibility of bidders will be considered in awarding contracts. The Owner does not obligate himself to accept the lowest or any other bid. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in any or all bids. Pump Repair

The vertical turbine pump in Well 6 requires replacement and motor repair. Bidders should submit quotes on this form to Tom Pollock by **February 21, 2017 by 2:30 p.m.** Replace pump and repair motor per the following table. Contractor is responsible for two consecutive negative total and fecal coliform bacteria samples more than 24 hours apart or they shall re-chlorinate the well at no cost to the owner.

Labor to re-install pump, packer, chlorinate well, and assist City with collection of 2 bacteria samples, 24 hours apart. Owner will submit samples to their lab.	
Replace all with new: 30 feet of 6" SCH 40 column pipe x 1-1/4" carbon steel shafting, brass bearing retainers, stainless shaft sleeves, rubber bearings, five(5) stainless steel 1-1/4" shaft couplings, stainless steel head shaft, 6' of 6" suction pipe and coupling, 6" flange pack, airline gauge, pressure gauge, copper airline, grease, oil, paint and all freight.	
New cast iron, enamel coated, brass impeller, brass fitted, vertical turbine pump bowl rated 500 gpm @ 235 ft TDH with 6" discharge	
Complete motor overhaul of 40 HP (oversized) hollow shaft motor including new upper and lower bearings, insulate and bake windings, dynamic balance, new sight glass, remake series connection, set of Polaris connectors for 460 volt (split bolts will not be accepted), paint, grease and oil, new stainless steel motor shaft and brass adj nut.	
Lansas or equivalent inflatable packer complete with copper airlines and set of gauges. 6" column by 12" casing, ~ 30" long. A single disc drawdown seal is not allowed must be an inflatable packer.
