

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Warner, Scoby, and Schuleit; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; City Engineer Hinken; and Public Safety Director Reiss.

Absent: Councilperson Moss.

Public Comments:

Michelle Reeves, on Grant Street, received a notice of trash can violation. They request that the violation letters be sent to the tenant and not the landlord.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held March 15, 2016.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period March 11, 2016 in the amount of \$122,626.89. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending March 29, 2016 in the amount of \$153,107.78.
3. Approval of the monthly financial report for all funds from February 28, 2016.
4. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, April 19, 2016 to receive comment on An Acquisition Grant from the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund to provide access to AG Davis Park.
5. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, April 19, 2016 to receive comment on A Development Grant from the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund to develop a Splash Pad in Tower Riverside Park.
6. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, April 19, 2016 to receive comment on A Development Grant from the Land and Water Conservation Fund to develop Flat River Access and Passage on the Flat River.
7. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, April 19, 2016 to receive comment on A Development Grant from the Recreation Passport Fund to develop a Skate Park in Veteran's Memorial Park.
8. Approval of the mayoral appointment of Linda Collins to the Board of Review as an alternate for a three year term ending December 31, 2020.

Council held a public hearing to receive comment on an amendment to Code of Ordinances Chapter 26 Article V being Disorderly Conduct.

Mayor Hoppough opened the public hearing at 7:40 p.m. and after receiving no comments closed the public hearing at 7:41 p.m.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To table the item until the April 19, 2016 City Council meeting. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request to close certain streets and traffic lanes and a portion of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail for the upcoming Yellow Jacket Challenge 5K Event on Sunday, April 17, 2016.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve closing the following Streets and Trail closures for April 17, 2016 from 12:00 noon to 3:00pm as presented:

- Yellow Jacket Drive from Greenville West Drive to Hillcrest Street.
- Blackburn Street from the Middle School Parking Lot to Hillcrest Street.
- Northbound lanes of Hillcrest Street north of Blackburn Street to Greenville West Drive.
- Southbound lane of Franklin Street from the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail to Montcalm Avenue.
- Westbound lane of Montcalm Avenue between Franklin Street and Hillcrest Street.
- One southbound lane of Hillcrest Street between Montcalm Avenue and Yellow Jacket Drive.
- A portion of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail from Hillcrest Street to Franklin Street.

Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered accepting the retirement letter from City Attorney, James Mullendore.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To accept the letter of retirement/resignation from City Attorney James Mullendore effective September 1, 2016 as submitted and authorize the City Manager to solicit for resumes/proposals for replacement. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the appointment of a committee of three people to research and make a recommendation on assignment of City Attorney duties.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To appoint Hoppough, Cunliffe, and Scoby to a committee to research and make a recommendation on assignment of City Attorney duties. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request from the Danish Festival to relocate the Tivoli Gardens to 116 East Cass Street for the 2016 Danish Festival.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request for permission to relocate the Tivoli Gardens for the 2016 Danish Festival beginning Friday, August 19, 2016 at 3:00pm to 11:59pm and Saturday, August 20, 2016 from 3:00pm to 11:59pm to 116 East Cass Street as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request from the Danish Festival for relief from the nuisance ordinance in connection with the Tivoli Gardens.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To approve the request to grant relief from the City's nuisance ordinance for the Tivoli Gardens located at 116 East Cass Street from 3:00pm to midnight on Friday, August 19, 2016 and from 3:00pm to midnight Saturday, August 20, 2016 as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered approval of a Professional Services Agreement with OHM to complete required biennial bridge inspections.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a contract to OHM Engineering Inc. of Lowell, Michigan for bridge inspection services in the amount not to exceed \$2,300 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for 2016 Spring Street Sweeping for City streets in connection with the Public Services Department.

Councilperson Warner MOVED: To award a bid for the annual one-time sweeping of all city streets to National Industrial Maintenance Inc. of Dearborn, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$10,800.00 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of shredded hardwood mulch for City parks in connection with the Public Services Department.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of 250 cubic yards of bulk mulch to Michigan Wood Fibers of Zeeland, Michigan in the amount

not to exceed \$3,312.50 as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.
