

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Warner, Moss, and Schuleit; City Manager Bosanic; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Councilperson Scoby.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held April 19, 2016 and special City Council meeting held April 26, 2016.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period April 8, 2016 in the amount of \$118,308.15. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending April 26, 2016 in the amount of \$150,218.96.
3. Approval of the Monthly financial report for all funds from March 31, 2016.

Council considered the approval of a street closure request from the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce in connection with the Annual Car Show.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the request to close the following streets from 3:00 pm until 9:30 pm for the upcoming Car Show to be held Saturday, August 6, 2016, from 5:00 pm to 8:30 pm as presented:

- M-91 from Washington Street to Montcalm Street.
- Cass Street from Franklin Street to Clay Street.
- Grove Street from Franklin Street to Clay Street.

Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of certain street closures in connection with the annual Gus Macker Basketball Tournament to be held July 9-10, 2016.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To close M-91 (Lafayette Street) between M-57 (Washington Street) and Montcalm Street, Cass Street and Grove Street to the alley/parking lot entrances east and west of Lafayette Street on Friday, July 9, 2016, at 5:00 pm until Sunday, July 10, 2016, at 9:00 pm. For the Gus Macker Basketball Tournament. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To accept the grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$8,000 for maintenance of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the adoption of the proposed 2016-2017 Items for Accomplishment.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed 2016-2017 Items For Accomplishment as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.
