

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Scoby, Warner, Moss, and Schuleit; City Manager Bosanic; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Public Comments: L. Charles Mulholland announced his run for the 70<sup>th</sup> House District Representative in State Legislature.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

- Cass Street from Irving Street to Franklin Street and Franklin Street from Cass Street To Montcalm Street – at 5:30pm August 19, 2016 until 7:00pm.
- Grove Street from Clay Street to Franklin Street – August 18, 2016 at 5:30pm to 9:00am August 21, 2016.
- Hillcrest Street from Blackburn to Cass Street; Cass Street from Hillcrest Street to Franklin Street; Franklin Street from Cass Street to Montcalm Street; Montcalm Street from Franklin Street to Clay Street; Clay Street from Montcalm Street to Cass Street; Cass Street from Clay Street to Hillcrest Street; Hillcrest Street from Cass Street to Blackburn Street – August 19, 2016 at 7:30pm to 10:00pm.
- Hillcrest Street from Blackburn Street to Cass Street; Cass Street from Hillcrest Street to Clay Street; Clay Street from Cass Street to Montcalm Street; Montcalm Street from Clay Street to Hillcrest Street and Bower Street from Cass Street to Montcalm Street – August 20, 2016 at 9:00am to 2:00pm.
- Southbound lane of Marvel Drive to Baldwin Lake Drive to South Street August 18, 2016, 8:45 to 10:00pm.

Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a Lease Agreement with Verizon for space on the Water Tower.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the proposed lease agreement with Verizon Wireless LLC for space on the Veteran's Park water tower and land under it as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered accepting a gift of money from the Bill Braman Endowment Fund.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To accept the gift of money from the Bill Braman Endowment Fund in the amount of \$50,000 over 10 years as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.
