

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Scoby, Warner, Moss, and Schuleit; City Manager Bosanic; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Public Comments:

- Newly appointed judge, Ron Schafer, introduced himself.
- Charles Noll, candidate for sheriff, introduced himself and gave his qualifications for the position.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item A-1 be added to New Business. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held June 7, 2016.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period May 20, 2016 in the amount of \$121,299.11. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending June 9, 2016 in the amount of \$211,122.16.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held May 26, 2016.
4. Approval of minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held May 10, 2016.
5. Approval of the monthly financial report for all funds from May 31, 2016.
6. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, July 19, 2016, to receive comment on an amendment to the Code of Ordinances Chapter 26 Article V being Disorderly Conduct.
7. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, July 19, 2016, to receive comment on the proposed application for a CDBG grant in connection with façade improvements in the downtown district.

Council held a public hearing to receive on the Proposed Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

Mayor Hoppough opened the public hearing at 7:45 p.m. and after receiving no comments closed the public hearing at 7:46 p.m. No action was taken.

Council considered increasing the current water and sewer rates by ten percent (10%) respectively.

Council considered the award of a bid for the installation of concrete pads for bike racks.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the installation of concrete pads for bike racks to Denny's Cement Work Inc. of Gowen, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$5,220 as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of 10 disc golf baskets for the Tower Mountain disc golf course.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of 10 disc golf baskets for the Tower Mountain Disc Golf Course to Disc Craft Inc. of Wixom, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$3,170 as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a contract with MDOT in connection with Baldwin Street and South Street Reconstruction Project.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve of Contract 16-5340 with MDOT in connection with Baldwin Street and South Street Reconstruction Project in the amount not to exceed \$375,000.00 and authorize the City Manager and Clerk-Treasurer to sign Contract 16-5340 as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the settlement agreement of June 6, 2016 between the City of Greenville and the POAM. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the settlement agreement of June 6, 2016 between the City of Greenville and the COAM. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
