

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons, Scoby, Schuleit, Warner, Moss, and Cunliffe; City Manager Bosanic; City Engineer Hinken; Public Services Director Pollock; and Clerk-Treasurer Rasmussen.

Absent: Lehman.

Public Comments: None.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held November 1, 2016.
2. Approval of payroll report for pay period ending October 21, 2016 in the amount of \$113,616.35. Approval of account payable report for period ending November 10, 2016 in the amount of \$608,639.48.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held October 27, 2016.
4. Approval of the mayoral reappointment of Douglas Hinken to the Greenville Area Community Foundation Board for a three-year term ending December 31, 2019.

Council considered the award of a bid for downtown parking lot snow plowing in connection with the Public Services Department.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the plowing of snow in city parking lots to Green Pro Landscape Management of Rockford, Michigan in the amount of \$500 per “push” for 2-6 inches of snow and \$750 per “push” for 6 plus inches of snow as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of Traffic Control Order No. 2016-03, establishing a YIELD sign on Maplewood at Meijer Drive intersection.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve Traffic Control Order 2016-03 establishing a YIELD sign on eastbound Meijer Drive as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.
