

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss and Scoby; City Manager George Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. No action taken.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

6. Approved the Mayoral reappointment of Larry Alman to the Transit L.A.C. (Local Advisory Council) for a three-year term ending December 31, 2016.
7. Approved the Mayoral reappointment of Jack Corner to the Zoning Board of Appeals and Adjustments for a three-year term ending December 31, 2016.

Council received a presentation from the Mid-Michigan District Health Department on Healthy Montcalm by Marcus Cheatham.

Council considered the approval of a year-end budget adjustment to comply with State requirements.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed internal transfers and amend the 2014 Budget accordingly. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To adopt the proposed Federal Guidelines and Maximum Asset Standards as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.
