

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Cunliffe, Greene and Scoby; City Manager George Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; Mark Reiss Public Safety Director.

Absent: Councilperson Moss.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meetings held February 4, 2014.
2. Approval of the payroll report for special pay period ending December 31, 2013 in the amount of \$22,426.07 and for regular pay period ending January 31, 2014 in the amount of \$110,899.23. Approval of accounts report for period ending February 10, 2014 in the amount of \$202,354.08
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held January 14, 2014.
4. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meetings held January 9, 2014.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a recommendation from the Planning Commission to rezone approximately 25 acres currently zoned Planned Unit Development (PUD) to Single Family Residential (R-1).

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the recommendation from the Planning Commission to deny the request for rezoning of approximately 25 acres from Planned Unit Development (PUD) to Single Family Residential (R-1) as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Motion carried by a vote of four ayes, one nay and one recuse.

Council considered the affirmation of Tom Pollock as Department Head in connection with being appointed Director of Public Services.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To consent to City Manager's appointment of Tom Pollock as Director of Public Services as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of "Turn Out" gear for the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of 16 sets of "Turn Out" gear for the Public Safety Department to 5 Alarm Inc. of Delafield, Wisconsin in the

amount not to exceed \$45,840 as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for timing services in connection with the Greenville Triathlon.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To award a bid for \$4,534.50 to Classic Race Management in the amount not to exceed \$4,534.50 as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
