

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Cunliffe, Greene, and Moss; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; City Engineer Hinken; Public Services Director Pollock.

Absent: Scoby (excused).

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held February 17, 2015 as amended.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending January 30, 2015 in the amount of \$113,672.97. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending February 25, 2015 in the amount of \$444,668.83.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held January 8, 2015.
4. Approval of monthly financial report for all funds from January 31, 2015.

Council considered the approval of a contract with Progressive AE for Geotechnical, Architectural and Engineering services for work at the Greenville Transit building.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To award a contract to Progressive AE of Grand Rapids, Michigan for Geotechnical, Architectural, and Engineering services in the amount of \$23,511 for the City's Transit building as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of street closures and temporary control measures in connection with Tri Greenville.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request to close the following streets and trail portions for the upcoming Tri-Greenville Triathlon event to be held May 30, 2015 as presented:

- Baldwin Street from South Street to Merritt Drive.
- Manoka Lake Boulevard from Merritt Drive to E. Baldwin Lake Drive.
- West Baldwin Lake Drive from Marvel Drive to Mills Park Drive.
- East Baldwin Lake Drive from Marvel Drive to the west City limit.
- Marvel Drive from South Street to West Baldwin Lake Drive.

- Mills Park Drive from West Baldwin Lake Drive to Pine Drive.
- Pine Drive from West Baldwin Lake Drive to Mills Park Drive.
- Como Lake Drive from East Baldwin Lake Drive to end of street.
- A portion of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail from Baldwin Street to Lafayette Street on May 30, 2015, from 5:00 am until 1:00 pm or following the last youth participant leaving the area.

IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER, THE FOLLOWING STREETS SHALL BE CLOSED, "NO PARKING" ZONES ESTABLISHED AND ONE-WAY STREET ESTABLISHED:

- Eastbound Meijer Drive from eastern-most drive of Meadow Ridge Apartments to the east end of the street.
- Northbound Maplewood Street from southern-most drive of Meijer Drive to the south end of the street.
- One-way established in the southbound lane of Maplewood and the westbound lane of Meijer Drive.
- Northbound Marvel Drive from Judd Street to South Street.
- "No Parking" zone established on east side of Marvel Drive.
- One-way established on southbound Marvel Drive in the northbound lane.

Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of an operating system for the supervisors control and data acquisition system (SCADA) in connection with the Water Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of an operating system for the supervisors control and data acquisition system (SCADA) to RS Technical Services, Inc. of Lowell, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$1,878.25 as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered increasing ridership fares for the Transit.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed increase in fares and wage rates for the Transit Department as presented with the fares to increase on April 1, 2015 and the wage increases to be effective on May 1, 2015. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of the use of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for the City of Greenville.
