

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; Dept. of Public Services Director Chesher; and Dept. of Public Safety Director Stuck.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held March 1, 2011.
2. Approval of payroll report for pay periods ending March 6, 2011 in the amount of \$134,584.42. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending March 10, 2011 in the amount of \$264,545.88.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular DDA meeting held February 8, 2011.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a recommendation from the Dangerous Building Committee in connection to a burned out structure located at 109 S. Greenville West Drive.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the recommendation from the Dangerous Building Committee in connection to a burned out structure located at 109 S. Greenville West Drive and authorize City Staff to commence with demolition procedures as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on an industrial facilities tax exemption application from Aggressive Tooling, Inc.

Councilperson Scoby RESOLVED: WHEREAS, Aggressive Tooling, Inc. is proposing to construct an addition to their building and purchase and install new equipment valued at \$150,000 and \$54,484, respectively; and

WHEREAS, their request is for the maximum exemption allowed by law which is for 12 years at 50% of the value; and

WHEREAS, the company anticipates creating 2 new jobs as a result of the investment;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The City of Greenville finds and determines that the Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption from Aggressive Tooling Inc. be

approved as presented and the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign all related documents. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted by a vote of seven ayes and no nays.

Council considered awarding a bid for sweeping services for spring sweeping of streets.

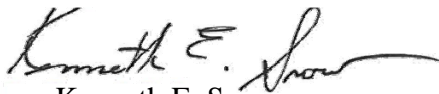

Council considered accepting a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the purchase of a breathing apparatus filling system air compressor for the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To accept a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the purchase of a breathing apparatus filling system air compressor for the Public Safety Department in the amount of \$38,000 and authorize a match in the amount not to exceed \$2,000 as presented. Councilperson Hoppough supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.
