

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street Greenville, MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; and Dept of Public Services Director Chesher.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held March 5, 2013.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending March 1, 2013 in the amount of \$142,135.80. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending March 8, 2013 in the amount of \$513,814.02.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held February 12, 2013.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a proposed recommendation from the Planning Commission to amend the sign section of the City's Zoning Ordinance.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed Planning Commissions recommendation to amend the sign section of the City's Zoning Ordinance as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for sweeping of City Streets.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: To award a bid for the sweeping of City streets to Tri-Us Services Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$10,021.50 as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of an amendment to the City's Plan document in connection with the ICMA Retirement Plan.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To approve the proposed Letter of Agreement amending the existing Agreement between the City of Greenville and ICMA-RC to provide for payroll deduction Individual Retirement Accounts (IRAs) for Employer's

employees (IRA Accountholders) as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a motion to enter into executive session to receive a report from Legal Counsel subject to Attorney/Client privilege.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: Council enters into executive session to receive a report subject to Attorney/Client privilege and to discuss litigation. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The regular meeting reconvenes. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.
