

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

April 01, 2014

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Schuleit, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss, Lehman and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; Waste Water Treatment Superintendant Wheat; Recreation and Community Center Director Berry; City Engineer Hinken.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held March 18, 2014.
2. Approval of minutes for the special City Council meeting held March 25, 2014.
3. Approval of the payroll report for period ending March 14, 2014 in the amount of \$122,454.49. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending March 25, 2014 in the amount of \$176,651.69.

Council received a presentation by Tim Scott from Montcalm County Central Dispatch regarding an upcoming 911 Surcharge renewal ballot request.

Council considered the awarding of a bid for the purchase of a combined vacuum sewer truck for the Motor Pool.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of a pre-owned Combination Vacuum Sewer Truck to Jack Doheny Supply Company of Northville, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$137,000 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the awarding of a bid for the 2014 Street Sweeping in connection with the Public Services Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the sweeping of city streets to National Industrial Maintenance Inc. of Dearborn, MI in the amount not to exceed \$9,968.00 as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To award a bid for the construction of a new recreation storage facility to Butterworth Builders Inc. of Greenville, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$25,653.91 as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
