

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI 48838.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Schuleit, and Moss; Assistant City Manager VanWynngarden; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Councilperson Scoby and City Manager Bosanic.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held March 13, 2012; special meeting held March 19, 2012; and regular meeting held March 20, 2012.
2. Approval of payroll report for pay period ending March 18, 2012 in the amount of \$133,742.40. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending March 23, 2012 in the amount of \$431,202.10.
3. Approval of minutes for the special Planning Commission meeting held March 13, 2012.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a proposed ordinance regarding the codification of all City Ordinances.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To adopt the ordinance enacting a new city code for the City of Greenville as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request from the Chamber of Commerce to close certain streets in connection with the annual Gus Macker and the annual Car Show.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the request from the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce to close certain streets in connection with the annual Gus Macker Tournament and the annual Car Show as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request to issue a change order to the WWTP project from Shawn Wheat in connection with a proposal to receive and treat septage.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To receive the presentation from WWTP Director Wheat and authorize the City Manager to issue a change order to the expansion

project to include the construction of the proposed structure to receive and dispense leachate and septage as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of the biennial City bridge inspection.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed contract with HH Engineering LTD in the amount not to exceed \$1,900 for biennial bridge inspection as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.
