

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Schuleit, and Moss; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; Deputy Clerk LeFever; Dept. of Public Works Director Chesher; and Dept. of Public Safety Director Stuck.

Council considered approval of check #68749 to the American Legion.


Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To table the discussion and approval until legal opinion and decision is made. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered awarding a bid for the purchase and installation of a new dump box for the Public Services Department.


