

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Warner, Moss, Schuleit and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; and Clerk-Treasurer Rasmussen.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and add Item E to the Consent Agenda and add Item C to New Business. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.
