

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

April 22, 2014

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Schuleit, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss, and Lehman; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; City Engineer Hinken.

Absent: Councilperson Scoby.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held April 1, 2014.
2. Approval of the payroll reports for period ending March 28, 2014, in the amount of \$115,157.14 and April 11, 2014, in the amount of \$114,098.77. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending April 10, 2014, in the amount of \$87,677.05.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held March 11, 2014.

Council considered a request to close certain streets and a portion of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail for the upcoming Yellow Jacket Challenge 5K Event.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed street closure request from Greenville Public Schools for the Yellow Jacket Challenge 5K Event April 27, 2014, from 12:00 noon to 3:00pm as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request to close certain streets, trail portions, "No Parking" zones and establishing One-Way streets for the upcoming Tri-Greenville Triathlon Event.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the proposed street and trail portions closure request for the Tri- Greenville Event May 31, 2014 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a street closure request from the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce in connection with the Annual Car Show.
