

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

May 06, 2014

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss, and Lehman; City Manager Bosanic; Acting Deputy Clerk Foster; City Engineer Hinken.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schulet seconded. Unanimously adopted.
