

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council received comment on the proposed ordinance regarding the Michigan Vehicle Code and Uniform Traffic Code.

Council considered the approval of a revision to flood right easements in connection with Edgewater Apartments.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To grant the partial release of flood rights in the Coleman Pond area for the Edgewater Apartment Development as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered placing delinquent utility bills and invoices on the tax roll.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To place the delinquent invoices on the tax roll as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the adoption of the 2015-2016 Items For Accomplishment List.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed 2015-2016 Items For Accomplishment as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.
