

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss, and Lehman; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Councilperson Scoby.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held June 17, 2014.
2. Approval of the payroll reports for period ending June 20, 2014 in the amount of \$125,337.44 and special pay period ending June 30, 2014 in the amount of \$19,007.05. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending June 24, 2014 in the amount of \$171,798.88 and period ending July 10, 2014 in the amount of \$161,456.79.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meetings held February 27, 2014, May 8, 2014, and June 12, 2014 and minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held June 10, 2014.
4. Approved of the 2014 proposed slate of officers for positions on the Michigan Municipal League Worker's Compensation Fund Board.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a recommendation from the Planning Commission for proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance regarding upstairs apartment use in downtown buildings.

Council considered the approval of the proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance regarding upstairs apartment use in downtown buildings.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the recommendation from the Planning Commission for amendments to Article VII, Section 46-160, the C-3 Zoning District and Deleting Section 46-236, Standards for Upper Story Residential Dwelling as presented or amended. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a crop lease in connection with the Greenville Airport.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the proposed crop lease for land at the Greenville Municipal Airport as presented. Council Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a fuel farm bid in connection with the Greenville Municipal Airport.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To award the contract for the purchase and installation of the fuel farm system for the Greenville Municipal airport to Sparling Corporation of Romulus, Michigan, low bidder meeting specifications in the amount not to exceed \$287,580.00 as presented. Council Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of the Transit Title VI Program.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the proposed Title VI Program in connection with the operations of the Greenville Transit system as presented. Council Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.
