

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI. 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough, Councilpersons Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item E be added to the Consent Agenda and Item E be added under New Business. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held June 19, 2012.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending June 24, 2012 in the amount of \$141,065.34, special pay period ending June 30, 2012 in the amount of \$28,997.91 and regular pay period ending July 8, 2012 in the amount of \$188,128.94.
3. Approval of accounts payable reports for period ending June 25, 2012 in the amount of \$493,297.53 and period ending July 11, 2012 in the amount of \$178,882.43.
4. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meetings held May 24, 2012, June 14, 2012, and June 28, 2012.
5. Approval of minutes of the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held June 12, 2012.
6. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, August 7, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. to receive comment on an Industrial Facilities Application for Performance Welding.
7. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, August 7, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. to receive comment on amending ordinances regulating fireworks.

Council reconsidered a recommendation from the Downtown Development Authority to approve the request from "Meet Downtown" to allow sidewalk sales.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request from "Meet Downtown" to allow the sidewalk sales to continue until 6:00 p.m. on Friday, July 20, 2012 as originally recommended by the Downtown Development Authority. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of street and parking lot closures for the Danish Festival.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To approve the proposed request from the Danish Festival Board for closure of a parking lot and streets as identified under items 1 and 3 as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a liquor license transfer from J.R.'s Roller Castle to 57 Brew Pub and Bistro.

Councilperson Scoby RESOLVED: WHEREAS, 57 Brew Pub and Bistro made application for a Class C Liquor License transfer from J.R.'s Roller Castle located at 1310 W. Washington Street, Greenville, MI. 48838; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the City Council to recommend approval of this application;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The application from 57 Brew Pub and Bistro for a Class C Liquor License be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the installation of curb and gutter at the Flat River Museum parking lot.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the installation of concrete curb and gutter to The Isabella Corporation of Mt. Pleasant, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$11,732.70 as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered an award of a bid for the paving of the Flat River Museum parking lot.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the paving of the museum parking lot to Superior Asphalt of Grand Rapids, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$37,880.00 as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of street closures for the Danish Festival's Grand Dansk Parade.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To approve the proposed street closures for the Grand Dansk Parade as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.
