

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; and City Engineer Hinken.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meetings held June 7, 2011 and June 21, 2011.
2. Approval of payroll reports for pay periods ending June 12, 2011 in the amount of \$131,954.35 and June 30, 2011 in the amount of \$136,666.39. Approval of accounts payable reports for periods ending June 27, 2011 in the amount of \$162,429.42 and July 11, 2011 in the amount of \$398,366.16.
3. Approved mayoral reappointment of Wendy Gladding to the Downtown Development Authority to complete another four-year term ending July 2015.

Council considered the approval of a contract with MDOT in connection with Phase 4 of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed contract with MDOT for Phase 4B of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a Plan Amendment in connection with the City's Health Insurance Program.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: This item be tabled for a future Council meeting. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a ballot proposal for this year's MML Worker's Compensation Board of Trustees Election.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed list of Candidates for the Worker's Compensation Board as presented. Councilperson Hoppough supported. Unanimously adopted.
