

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan, 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Smith, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden and Recreation Director Berry.

Absent: Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Hoppough supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held July 20, 2010.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending July 11, 2010, in the amount of \$137, 13.50. Approval of accounts payable for period ending July 23, 2010, in the amount of \$514,248.28.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held June 24, 2010 and July 8, 2010.

Council considered the award of a bid to construct the tunnel in connection with the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: To hold a special meeting for Tuesday, August 10, 2010 to consider bids related to the Community Center solar project and the M-57 tunnel project. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request from a resident to close off North Franklin Street from Oak Street to Union Street.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request to close Franklin Street from Oak Street to Union Street for 4 Varsity Football games on a progressive basis throughout the season. Councilperson Hoppough supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of the proposed locations of "No Dogs Allowed" signs in connection with the Danish Festival.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed map illustrating the locations of "No Pets Allowed" signs in connection with the Danish Festival as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a proposed contract for towing services for the City of Greenville.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed contract for Towing Services as presented with the amendment as stated. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid to re-lamp softball fields at Alan G. Davis Park.


Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for re-lamping Alan G. Davis Softball Fields to Musco Sports Lighting in the amount not to exceed \$6,900 as presented. Councilperson Hoppough supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the countywide transportation initiative.

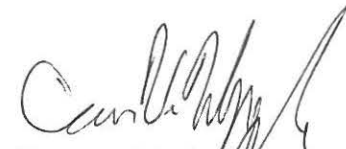
No action was taken.
