

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Greene, Cunliffe, and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Moss and Schuleit

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the for the regular City Council meeting held July 21, 2015.
2. Approval of payroll report for special pay period ending June 30, 2015 in the amount of \$16,448.79 and for regular pay period ending July 3, 2015 in the amount of \$121,716.26. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending July 24, 2015 in the amount of \$150,592.35.
3. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, September 1, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. at City Hall to receive comment on an Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption application from Huntington Foam, Inc.

Council held a public hearing to receive comment on the filing of a special assessment roll and notice of public hearing regarding proposed street improvements in the Forest View Development.

Mayor Hoppough opened the public hearing at 7:39. Council received the following public comments:

- Earl Erland submitted a written protest.
- Lois Simpson asked the assessment amount that council would be approving and hopes the City follows through on completing the project.
- Julie Anderson says it is benefit to the neighborhood and properties.
- Megan Ingles is in support of the project.
- Jeff Platko when will assessment start and why pave before new construction.
- Steve Hanson says the City owning the road is a huge benefit. Need to identify laterals.

Hearing no further comments, Mayor Hoppough closed the public hearing at 7:46.

Council considered a request to close the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail for the Annual Le Tour De Donut Race.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request to close a portion of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail – that being from Tower Mountain to Walnut Street - September 19, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon for the Le Tour De Donut Road Race as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a resolution confirming the special assessment roll in connection with the Forest View Street Improvement project.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To recuse Councilperson Lehman from this item due to direct financial interest. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the proposed resolution confirming the special assessment roll in the amount of \$115,320 in connection with the Forest View Street project as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Failed due to not receiving five affirmative votes with a vote of four ayes, one recused, two absent, and no nays.

Council considered approval of amendments to legal description in the Protective Covenants and Restrictions for the Greenville Industrial Park.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the amendments to the legal description for the Protective Covenants and Restrictions for the City's Industrial Park as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a notice to proceed for the purchase of snow removal equipment for the Greenville Area Municipal Airport.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To approve the proposed notice to proceed with the purchase of snow removal equipment for the Greenville Area Municipal Airport in the amount not to exceed \$184,950 as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
