

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Greene, and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Councilpersons Cunliffe and Moss.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item E is added to New Business. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meetings held July 15, 2014.
2. Approval of the payroll report for regular pay period ending July 4, 2014 in the amount of \$121,438.18. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending July 24, 2014 in the amount of \$106,928.909.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held June 26, 2014.
4. Approved the Mayoral appointment of Corey Smith to the Planning Commission to complete the three-year term of former Commissioner Ron Blanding expiring December 31, 2014
5. Approved the Mayoral appointment of Joe Corcoran to the Economic Development Corporation for a six-year term to expire December 31, 2020.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a dangerous building situation located at 112 W. Gibson.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To authorize the demolition of the structures in accordance with the findings of the building officials under the dangerous building ordinance and invoice the property owner for the cost as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered decertifying Adam Eggleston as the assistant City attorney.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To decertify Adam Eggleston as Assistant City Attorney as of effective date August 12, 2014 as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a contract with MDOT in connection with the Transit Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed contract with the Michigan Department of Transportation for authorization to purchase two new buses for the City's Transit Department in the amount of \$188,733 as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a Traffic Control Order rescinding a prior TCO establishing "NO PARKING AT ANY TIME" signs on the west side of Edgewood Street between Fairplains Avenue and East Oak Street.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve Permanent Traffic Control Order No. 2014-1 rescinding TCO No. 92-1 that there shall be "NO PARKING AT ANY TIME" on the west side of Edgewood Street between Fairplains Avenue and East Oak Street. "NO PARKING AT ANY TIME" on the west side of South Edgewood Street shall remain in effect between East Oak Street and M-57 (East Washington Street) as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the acknowledgement that MainStreet Planning Company will be operating as Wade Trim, Inc.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To acknowledge that MainStreet Planning Company will be operating as Wade-Trim Inc. and authorize all city planning files be forwarded accordingly as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a motion to enter into executive session to discuss union negotiations with the POAM and the COAM.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: Council enters into executive session to discuss union negotiations with the POAM and the COAM. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The regular meeting reconvenes. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the POAM Letter of Understanding Regarding Second Year Wage and Health Care Reopener. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the COAM Letter of Understanding Regarding Second Year Wage and Health Care Reopener. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.
