

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Councilperson Schuleit.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held July 16, 2013.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending July 19, 2013 in the amount of \$112,974.48. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending July 25, 2013 in the amount of \$314,616.50.

Council considered the approval of a Traffic Control Order establishing a stop sign.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve proposed Traffic Control Order No. 13-02 establishing a STOP sign at the intersection of Yellow Jacket Drive and Hillcrest Street as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a contract with MDOT in connection with the purchase of a Transit Department bus.

Councilperson Lehman RESOLVED: WHEREAS the City of Greenville wishes to purchase another transit bus; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville received a contract with the Michigan Department of Transportation for the purchase of a new transit bus in the amount of \$122,400; and

WHEREAS: The grant is comprised of fully funded Federal and State funds with no local match required;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The proposed contract with the Michigan Department of Transportation in the amount of \$122,400 for a new transit bus is approved as presented.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to sign all related documents. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council received a report from the City Manager on the Personal Property Tax issue and its potential impact on the City of Greenville. No action was taken.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.
