

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI. 48838.

Present: Mayor Hoppough, Councilpersons Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; and Assistant City Manger VanWyn garden.

Absent: Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held July 17, 2012.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending July 22, 2012 in the amount of \$121,104.49. Approval of accounts payable for period ending July 25, 2012 in the amount of \$617,681.40.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held July 12, 2012.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on an Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption application for Performance Welding.

Councilperson Lehman RESOLVED: WHEREAS, Performance Welding, Inc, located in the City's Industrial Park has applied for an Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption; and

WHEREAS, there will be \$50,000 of new building improvements and this will create 3 new jobs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: The City's property tax to be abated over the 12 year period is \$2,300 and the total amount for all taxing authorities for the same period is \$9,900.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The IFE application from Performance Welding is approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on amending ordinances regulating fireworks.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed ordinance regulating the use of fireworks in the City of Greenville as proposed or amended. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a Fixed Based Operating Agreement.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed Fixed Base Operator Agreement with Marceco Inc. as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a Land Lease Agreement at the Greenville Municipal Airport.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the land lease agreement with Marceco Inc. in connection with land at the Greenville Municipal Airport as presented. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a permit for a fireworks display at the Greenville Public Schools.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the proposed permit for a fireworks display from the Greenville Public Schools as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Councilpersons Hoppough, Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Moss and Scoby concurred. Councilperson Schuleit did not concur. Adopted by a vote of six ayes and one nay.

Council considered the award of a bid for marking pavement.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the marking of pavement on major city streets to Michigan Pavement Markings Inc. of Wyoming, MI., low bidder meeting specifications in the amount not to exceed \$8,480.00 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the adoption of a revised drug and alcohol policy for the Transit Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To adopt the revised drug and alcohol policy for the Transit Department as proposed. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a petition to annex territory into the City of Greenville.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To accept the petition to annex territory and authorize the City Manager and the City Council Annexation Committee to pursue a mutual annexation with Eureka Charter Township through Public Act 108. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.
