

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Greene, Moss, Schuleit, Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Cunliffe

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the for the regular City Council meeting held August 4, 2015.
2. Approval of payroll report for special pay period ending June 19, 2015 in the amount of \$126,957.72 and for regular pay period ending July 17, 2015 in the amount of \$113,258.90. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending August 11, 2015 in the amount of \$208,241.37.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held July 14, 2015.
4. Approval of Mayoral reappointment of Wendy Gladding to the Downtown Development Authority board for a four-year term ending July 31, 2019.

Old Business:

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To recuse Councilperson Lehman from this item due to direct financial interest. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council reconsidered a resolution confirming the special assessment roll in connection with the Forest View Street Improvement project.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the proposed resolution confirming the special assessment roll in the amount of \$115,320 in connection with the Forest View Street project as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

New Business:

Council considered the award of a bid for theater drapery in connection with the Greenville Area Community Center.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase and installation of drapery at the Greenville Area Community Center to Tobin Lake Sales of Whitmore Lake,

Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$8,850 as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for audit services for the City’s auditing services.

Councilperson Lehman: To award a contract for the performance of the Annual City Audit for Fiscal 2015, Fiscal 2016 and Fiscal 2017 audits, to Gabridge & Company of Grand Rapids Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$48,120 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of turnout gear for the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of 3 set of “Turn Out Gear” for the Public Safety Department to 5 Alarm Fire of Delafield, Wisconsin in the amount not to exceed \$6,036 as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the temporary street closure on Montcalm Street from Franklin Street to Irving Street and on Franklin Street from Montcalm Street to the Franklin Street Bridge and placing temporary no parking signs on the south side of west Montcalm Street from Franklin Street to Irving Street in connection with the Danish Festival.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the temporary street closure on Montcalm Street from Franklin Street to Irving Street and on Franklin Street from Montcalm to the Franklin Street Bridge from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and placing temporary no parking signs on the south side of west Montcalm Street from Franklin Street to Irving Street from 5:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.
