

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Greene, Scoby, Cunliffe, and Moss; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item C is added to New Business. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meetings held August 5, 2014.
2. Approval of payroll reports for regular pay period ending July 18, 2014 in the amount of \$112,674.40 and regular pay period ending August 1, 2014 in the amount of \$115,552.11. Accounts payable report for period ending August 11, 2014 in the amount of \$327,664.50.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held July 8, 2014.
4. Set a Public Hearing for Tuesday, September 16, 2014 to receive comment on an Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption application (IFT) from Greenville Tool and Die Company.

Council considered a proposed 5-year contract with the Michigan Department of Transportation for State Trunkline Maintenance for State Trunklines in the City of Greenville.

Councilperson Scoby RESOLVED: To approve the proposed contract with the MDOT for maintenance on State Trunklines in the City of Greenville for a 5 year period and designate Tom Pollock, Director of Public Services, as the Contract Administrator as presented.

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville is desirous of entering into a contract with the State for maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: The City of Greenville and the State of Michigan enter into a contract for which the term is in effect from October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2019, and in which the City will provide maintenance on these sections of State Trunklines within the City for the next five (5) years. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a Michigan Department of Transportation contract in connection with funding for Transit Building Improvements.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the proposed contract (Z5/R2) with the Michigan Department of Transportation for grant funding to make improvements to the Transit Building in the amount of \$125,000 as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request from Republic Services to extend the Solid Waste Contract for an additional five years.

No action taken.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.
