

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Greene, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; City Clerk-Treasurer Hool; and City Engineer Hinken.

Absent: Councilperson Cunliffe.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held August 6, 2013.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending August 2, 2013 in the amount of \$117,163.59. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending August 8, 2013 in the amount of \$136,473.62.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held May 9, 2013. Approval of DDA minutes for the regular meeting held June 11, 2013.

Council considered the approval of a bid for the removal and replacement of sidewalk slabs throughout the City.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the removal and replacement of City sidewalk slabs to D&R Concrete of Mecosta, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$9,549.00 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a John Deere Gator bid in connection with the Public Services Department.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of a John Deere Gator to Nelson's Speed Shop of Greenville, MI in the amount not to exceed \$7,276 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a motion to enter into executive session to discuss with legal counsel a proposed settlement agreement with Eureka Township in connection with the pending FOIA litigation.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: Council enter into Executive Session to discuss with legal counsel a proposed settlement agreement with Eureka Township in connection with the pending FOIA Litigation. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The regular meeting reconvene. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To reject Eureka Townships FOIA settlement offer and direct the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate a settlement. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.
