

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden, Clerk-Treasurer Hool; and Department of Public Safety Director Pousak.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the purchase of a new public safety cruiser.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of a 2013 Dodge Charger patrol vehicle to Grand Dodge/Jeep/Chrysler of Lowell, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$22,277.89 as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered appointing a City Council member to the Annexation Committee.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: John Hoppough be nominated and appointed to the Annexation Committee. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a motion to enter into executive session to discuss pending litigation.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: Council enter into executive session to discuss a letter from legal counsel under attorney-client privilege in connection with ongoing litigation. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The regular meeting reconvene. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.
