

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Scoby, Cunliffe, and Moss; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Councilperson Greene (excused).

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item D is added to the Consent Agenda. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meetings held August 19, 2014.
2. Approval of payroll reports for regular pay period ending August 15, 2014 in the amount of \$113,573.89. Accounts payable report for period ending August 25, 2014 in the amount of \$223,513.21.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held July 10, 2014.
4. Set a public hearing to receive comment on a recommendation from the Planning Commission for the proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance to clarify terms and requirements for nursing homes and assisted living and foster care facilities for Tuesday, September 16, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. at City Hall.

Council considered a land lease agreement to plant and harvest crops on City owned property.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed land lease agreement with Jed Welder to till, plant and harvest crops on approximately 22 acres of City owned property located on Backus Road in the amount of \$1,500 for a one year period beginning September 3, 2014 as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered amending the legal description of the Industrial Park Protective Covenants to include additional lands.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed amendment to the Industrial Park Protective Covenant legal description as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request to close the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail for the Annual Le Tour De Donut Race.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the request to close a portion of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail- that being from Tower Mountain to Walnut Street- September 20, 2014 from 8:00am to 12:00 noon for the Le Tour De Donut Road Race as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.
