

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWynngarden; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; City Engineer Hinken; and Transit Office Manager Raymor.

Absent: Councilperson Cunliffe.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved except for the Council minutes from August 16, 2011. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of payroll report for pay period ending August 7, 2011 in the amount of \$131,790.01 and pay period ending August 21, 2011 in the amount of \$130,139.50. Approval of accounts payable reports for period August 25, 2011 in the amount of \$178,142.41.
2. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, September 20, 2011, at 7:30 p.m. to consider recommendations from the Planning Commission for proposed amendments to the City's Zoning Ordinance.
3. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, September 20, 2011, at 7:30 p.m. to consider an ordinance regulating demolition in the City of Greenville.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a proposal to remove certain streetlights in the City of Greenville. No action was taken.

Council considered a lease agreement for planting and harvesting crops at the airport.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: To approve the proposed agreement with Jim Barens of Mid Michigan Helicopter for farming rights to portions of the City's property located at the Greenville Municipal Airport. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a license for use of Water Works Park in connection with the Fred Meijer Heartland Trail.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: To approve the proposed license agreement granting use of the proposed location within the Water Works Park for connection of the

Fred Meijer Heartland Trail to the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail and the Walnut/Ranney connector as presented. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a contract with BS&A in connection with the Assessor Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the purchase of proposed software from BS&A in the amount not to exceed \$9,000 to be paid in two installments over 2 years for the Assessing Department. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.
