

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Cunliffe, Greene, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Items D & E be added. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held September 3, 2013.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending August 30, 2013 in the amount of \$116,695.18. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending September 10, 2013 in the amount of \$318,527.18.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held August 22, 2013.
4. Approved a resolution adding Ada Township as a GVMC member and withdrawing the Village of Sparta and Sparta Township as a GVMC members.
5. Approved a resolution adding the Village of Sand Lake as a GVMC member.

Council considered the approval and adoption of the Title VI Plan in connection with the State of Michigan.

Council considered the approval of a lighting contract with Consumer's Energy. No action was taken.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed Title VI Plan for the City of Greenville in connection with non-discrimination laws as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a motion to enter into executive session to discuss pending litigation in connection with the Uni-Solar bankruptcy and to discuss a letter subject to attorney/client privilege and to discuss a letter from legal counsel subject to attorney/client privilege.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: Council enter into executive session to discuss pending litigation in connection with the Uni-Solar bankruptcy. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The regular meeting reconvene. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The regular meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.
