

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, located in the Municipal Complex, 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough, Councilpersons Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held September 4, 2012.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending September 2, 2012 in the amount of \$125,300.14. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending September 12, 2012 in the amount of \$209,315.36.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular DDA meeting held August 14, 2012.
4. Considered rescheduling the October 2, 2012 regular City Council meeting to October 1, 2012.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase and installation of glycol for the chillers in the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase and installation of glycol for the chillers in the Public Safety Department to Advantage Mechanical Refrigeration Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$2,620 as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a temporary license for 210 S. Lafayette Street to occupy City sidewalk to paint a building.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To grant Roy LaMarte a ten day license from October 1, 2012 to October 10, 2012 to erect scaffolding and to block the City sidewalk in front of and alongside his building at 210 S. Lafayette Street so he can paint and make improvements to his building. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a parade route utilizing a City Park and streets for the Greenville Public School's Annual Homecoming Parade.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request from the Greenville Public Schools to use City Parks and Streets for the Annual Football Homecoming Parade as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the placement of speed bumps on Yellow Jacket Drive during fall and spring activities.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the purchase and installation of bumper blocks and signs along Yellow Jacket Drive as presented. Councilperson Lehman supported. Councilpersons Hoppough, Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Schuleit and Scoby concurred. Councilperson Moss did not concur. Motion passed by a vote of 6 ayes and one nay.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.
