

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Smith, Moss and Scoby; City Manger Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; City Engineer Hinken; and Dept. of Public Safety Director Stuck.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item E be added under New Business. Councilperson Hoppough supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held September 7, 2010.
2. Approval of payroll report for pay period ending September 5, 2010, in the amount of \$137,408.98. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending September 10, 2010, in the amount of \$358,722.39.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular DDA meeting held August 10, 2010. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held August 12, 2010 and August 26, 2010.
4. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, October 19, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. to receive comment on an IFE application from United Solar Ovonic.

A presentation was given by Public Safety Director Stuck to recognize the young man who jumped in to save a young girl at the dam earlier this summer.

Council considered a request to use the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail for a fund raiser event and to use golf carts on the trail.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: To approve the request to use the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail for a fund raiser event, and to include the use of golf carts, if necessary, as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a contract with MDOT in connection with the North Lafayette Street Project.

Councilperson Hoppough RESOLVED: WHEREAS, the City of Greenville is desirous of having new curb, gutter and sidewalk on North Lafayette Street between Gibson Street and Pearl Street; and

WHEREAS, MDOT has agreed to the project where all concrete curbs and gutters would be retrofitted after the fact if the City would assist them by going to various businesses and requesting that curb entrances be closed where they are no longer needed or are duplicated.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The City of Greenville approve the proposed contract with MDOT for the installation of curb, gutter and sidewalk on North Lafayette Street between Gibson Street and Pearl Street as presented, contingent on a mutual agreement between MDOT and the City Manager after doing a project site review, and the City Mayor and Clerk are authorized to sign all related documents. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a recommendation for the DDA to close certain streets in connection with the M-106 Halloween event.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request from local radio station M-106, to close Cass Street between Clay and Lafayette Streets from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on October 29, 2010 for their annual Halloween event, as presented. Councilperson Hoppough supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: Council enter into Executive Session to discuss personnel issues. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: The regular meeting reconvene. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Smith supported. Unanimously adopted.
