

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Hoppough, Lehman, Cunliffe, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; and City Engineer Hinken.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Moss **MOVED:** The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held September 20, 2011.
2. Approval of payroll report for pay period ending September 18, 2011 in the amount of \$135,490.63. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending September 26, 2011 ending in the amount of \$416,450.22.

Council considered a recommendation from the DDA to close a portion of Cass Street.

Councilperson Hoppough **MOVED:** To approve the closure of a portion of Cass Street between Lafayette Street and Clay Street on October 31, 2011 from 3 to 6 pm for the 11th Annual WGLM Halloween Bash as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a recommendation from the DDA to approve a resolution authorizing the continuance of the City's participation in the Michigan Main Street Program.

Councilperson Scoby **RESOLVED:** WHEREAS, the Greenville Downtown Development Authority is interested in continuing the Michigan Main Street program as an Associate Level community; and

WHEREAS, this program would provide training on how to effectively promote our downtown to customers and potential businesses through the Main Street Four-Point Approach; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville City Council has recently shown support for historic preservation in the downtown through the formation of a Historic District Commission; and

WHEREAS, the DDA has already committed to covering the costs of attending training sessions held throughout the year, out of their own budget;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Greenville City Council offers a Resolution of Support and Cooperation to the Greenville Downtown Development Authority in their application to the Michigan Main Street Program as presented. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for replacement of mechanical equipment at the Community Center.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the replacement of mechanical equipment at the Community Center to advantage Mechanical Refrigeration of Comstock Park, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$37,950 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: To hold a special City Council meeting on October 11, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. to consider a recommendation for the award of a bid for the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Hoppough MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.
