

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville MI 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Cunliffe, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Greene.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item C is added to new business. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held October 1 2013.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending September 27, 2013 in the amount of \$120,416.60. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending October 10, 2013 in the amount of \$229,865.41.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on a recommendation from the Planning Commission to amend Section 6.04 of Ordinance No. 46, the Zoning Ordinance.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the recommendation from the Planning Commission to amend Section 6.04 of Chapter 46 of the Code of Ordinances as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered approving a bid for the purchase of carpet for the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a bid for the removal, purchase and installation of carpet in the Public Safety Department to Gilberts' Carpets Plus of Rockford, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$7,893.38 as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request from the Greenville Area Chamber to close certain streets for the upcoming Christmas Parade to be held Friday, December 6, 2013.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the request from the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce to close certain streets for the upcoming annual Christmas

Parade to be held Friday, December 6, 2013 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a proposed settlement agreement with Eureka Township regarding the FOIA lawsuit.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the proposed settlement agreement as presented and authorize the City Manger to sign on behalf of the City. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.
