

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a \$2 million SAW grant from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality.

Councilperson Green MOVED: To approve the SAW Grant Award – Project #1474-01 in the amount of \$2 million with the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.
