

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meetings held October 21, 2014.
2. Approval of payroll reports for regular pay period ending October 10, 2014 in the amount of \$115,048.94. Accounts payable report for period ending October 24, 2014 in the amount of \$205,585.52.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Economic Development Corporation meetings held September 24, 2012 and August 18, 2014.
4. Approval of the Monthly Financial Report for All Funds as of September 30, 2014.

Council considered the approval of closing certain streets in connection with the Annual Christmas Parade.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the closure of certain streets for the Annual Christmas Parade Friday, December 5, 2014 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. as follows:

- Lafayette Street from Washington Street to Gibson Street
- Clay Street from Grove Street to south drive at City Lot 5
- Cass Street from Lafayette Street to Clay Street
- Grove Street at Lafayette Street intersection
- Montcalm Street at Lafayette Street intersection
- State Street from Lafayette Street to Clay Street

Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered approving a fee schedule for services in connection with the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To approve the proposed fee schedule for services in connection with the Public Safety Department as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered authorization and payment for an appraisal of property in connection with a tax appeal.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To authorize and fund an appraisal of the Meijer property with John Widmer in the amount not to exceed \$12,000 as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a resolution establishing regulations pertaining to the supply of water from the City Water Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: This item be tabled for a future Council meeting. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.
