

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough, Councilpersons Cunliffe, Greene, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyn garden; City Engineer Hinken; Recreation Director Berry; and DPS Director Chesher.

Councilperson Moss **MOVED:** The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a proposal from the Triathlon Committee in connection with the proposed triathlon.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: Council resolves to endorse the committee’s plan and encourage the committee to continue. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.
