

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Pro-Tem Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Mayor Snow and Councilperson Lehman.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item VIC be added to the Agenda. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held November 1, 2011.
2. Approval of payroll report for pay period ending November 3, 2011 in the amount of \$128,790.76. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending November 10, 2011 in the amount of \$221,924.91.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular DDA meeting held October 11, 2011.
4. Approved Mayoral appointment of Larry Alman to the Greenville Transit Local Advisory Committee for a term ending December 31, 2013.
5. Approved Mayoral appointment of Douglas Stek to the Greenville Historical District Commission for a term ending December 31, 2014.
6. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, December 6, 2011 to receive comment on the closure of a Community Development Block Grant in connection with Uni-Solar.

Council considered a request to close certain streets and trail for fundraiser event.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To approve the proposed request to close certain streets and a portion of the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail as presented with an administrative fee in the amount of \$500. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request for license to use public property to install and use a boat dock on Baldwin Lake.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the request for a license to build a dock on the City's property as presented. No support. Motion failed.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: To deny the request for license to build a dock on the City's property as proposed. Councilperson Moss supported. Mayor Pro-Tem Hoppough and Councilperson Moss supported. Councilpersons Cunliffe, Schuleit and Scoby did not concur. Motion failed.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: This item is tabled until the next regular City Council meeting. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a request from Allied Waste Disposal, Inc. to deviate from the City's waste hauling contract.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To deny the request seeking relief to the City's Waste Hauling Contract with Allied Waste Disposal Inc. as presented. No support. Motion failed.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the request seeking relief to the City's Waste Hauling Contract with Allied Waste Disposal, Inc. as presented and amend the current contract with Allied to reflect this change. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.
