

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Scoby, Cunliffe, Greene, and Moss; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; City Engineer Hinken; Recreation and Community Center Director Berry

Absent: Schuleit (excused)

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meetings held November 4, 2014.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending October 24, 2014 in the amount of \$115,088.57. Accounts payable report for period ending November 10, 2014 in the amount of \$166,195.49.
3. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held August 28, 2014.
4. Approval of minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held October 14, 2014

Council removed from table the water resolution establishing regulations pertaining to the supply of water from the City Water Department.

Councilperson Greene RESOLVED: To approve the proposed resolution establishing regulations pertaining to the supply of water from the City Water Department as presented.

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville Code of Ordinances provides in Section 44-56 that the City Council may by resolution, make such regulations as it deems necessary pertaining to the supply of water from the City Water Department, which rules and regulations shall apply equally to all persons who are connected to the City's water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the ability to obtain water service from the City Water Department is a privilege, the exercise of which may be conditioned upon compliance with regulations that the City Council establishes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenville that:

- i. The City Council deems it necessary to the efficient operation of its Water Department to make the following water supply regulations:
 - a) All persons who are connected to the City of Greenville's water distribution system that are located within the Wellhead Protection District are prohibited from using private water supply wells.
 - b) The City Council is authorized to establish special water rates for lawn sprinkling and landscape watering to reflect that such water is not discharged to the City's wastewater treatment plant.
 - c) Private water supply wells used for lawn sprinkling or landscape watering may be used for those purposes as long as such wells are located outside of the City of Greenville Wellhead Protection District as described in Chapter 18 of the City of Greenville Code of Ordinances.
- ii. These regulations shall be given immediate effect.
- iii. All resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for the Bikes Need Parking Too project.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To accept the award of a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$13,122 for "Bikes Need Parking Too" as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for curtains and audio upgrade for the Greenville Area Community Center.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To accept the grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$18,412.82 for the purchase and installation of stage curtains and audio equipment for the Greenville Area Community Center as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for three (3) scoreboards for Alan Davis Park

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To accept the grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$19,630.00 for three (3) scoreboards for Alan G. Davis Park as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered an award of a contract for professional services for engineering design in connection with the Greenville West Drive Bridge.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award a contract for professional engineering services for preparation of plans and specifications for bridge repairs to HH Engineering Ltd. of Lowell, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$4,700 as presented. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered appointing members to the Recreation Master Plan Committee.
