

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Moss, Schuleit, Scoby, Lehman and Greene; City Manager Bosanic; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; Public Services Director Pollock.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item C is added to New Business. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held November 17, 2015.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending November 6, 2015 in the amount of \$115,578.55. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending November 25, 2015 in the amount of \$163,102.31.
3. Approval of the monthly financial report for all funds from October 31, 2015.

Council considered a land lease agreement to plant and harvest crops on City owned property.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed land lease agreement with Jed Welder to till, plant, and harvest crops on approximately 22 acres of City owned property located on Backus Road in the amount of \$1,500 for a one year period beginning September 4, 2015 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for tub grinding services in connection with the Solid waste services.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the tub grinding of brush and logs at the City's compost facility to GreenRock Landscape Supply Inc. of Rockford, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$13,050 as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of closing certain streets in connection with the Annual Christmas Parade.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the closure of certain streets for the Annual Christmas Parade Friday, December 4, 2015 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. as follows:

- Lafayette Street from Washington Street to Gibson Street
- Clay Street from Grove Street to south drive at City Lot 5
- Cass Street from Lafayette Street to Clay Street
- Grove Street at Lafayette Street intersection
- Montcalm Street at Lafayette Street intersection
- State Street from Lafayette Street to Clay Street

Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.
