

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Schuleit, Lehman, Greene, Cunliffe, Moss and Scoby; City Manager George Bosanic; Public Safety Director Reiss; Recreation Director Berry; Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented and Item F was added to New Business. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held November 19, 2013.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period December 31, 2013 in the amount of \$19,866.03. Approval of accounts payable report for period November 27, 2013 in the amount of \$193,047.23.

Council received a presentation on the 2012-2013 Annual Audit from the auditing firm of Gabridge and Company.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the 2012-2013 Annual Audit as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for turnout gear in connection with the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To accept the grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for "Turnout Gear" for the Public Safety Department in the amount of \$45,840 as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered accepting the award of the Greenville Area Community Foundation grant to purchase a Polaris Brutus HD or similar utility vehicle for the Greenville Recreation Department.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To accept the Grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$16,470 for the purchase of a utility vehicle as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered accepting the award of the Greenville Area Community Foundation grant to establish a social art studio at the Greenville Area Community Center.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To accept the grant award from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$3,428.76 to establish a social art studio at the Greenville Area Community Center as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered accepting the award of the Greenville Area Community Foundation grant for “Doing the Unthinkable” in connection with Recreation Department.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To accept the grant from the Greenville Area Foundation in the amount of \$6,800 as presented. Councilperson Scoby seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council received a presentation from members of the Montcalm Alliance Committee on the Proposed Economic Development Plan.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To endorse the efforts of the Montcalm Alliance Committee’s proposed Economic Development Plan. Councilperson Greene seconded. Adopted with a vote of six ayes from Councilpersons Scoby, Hoppough, Schuleit, Greene, Cunliffe, and Moss, and one nay from Councilperson Lehman.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To direct the City Manager to draft a resolution of appreciation to the Greenville Area Community Foundation. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.
