

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Lehman, Greene, Schuleit, Moss and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; Clerk-Treasurer Hool; Recreation/Community Center Director Berry; and City Engineer Hinken.

Absent: None.

Consent Agenda Approved:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held November 20, 2012
2. Approval of payroll reports for regular pay period ending November 11, 2012 in the amount of \$123,655.08 and for special pay period ending November 30, 2012 in the amount of \$33,517.99. Approval of accounts payable report for period ending November 27, 2012 in the amount of \$150,521.57.
3. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, December 18, 2012 to receive comment on a recommendation from the Planning Commission for rezoning of property.

Council considered the award of a contract to retain a consultant management company in connection with the Tri-Greenville Triathlon.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve a contract with 1 BOLD STEP for event management services in connection with the proposed triathlon as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered moving the City Council meetings in January 2013 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesdays.

Councilperson Greene MOVED: To schedule January 2013 City Council meetings for Tuesday, January 8<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, January 22<sup>nd</sup> as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered approving a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for the Recreation Department's Youth Gymnastics Equipment.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To accept the grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for the purchase of gymnastics equipment in the amount of \$4,768 as presented. Councilperson Schuleit supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered approving a grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation for keyless entry and security system for the GACC.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To accept the grant from the Greenville Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$10,893 for an electronic access control system and security system as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: Council entered into executive session to discuss a memorandum subject to attorney/client privilege. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The regular meeting reconvened. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting is adjourned. Councilperson Greene supported. Unanimously adopted.
