

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI 48838, at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Snow, Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Moss and Scoby; Assistant City Manager VanWyngarden; and Clerk-Treasurer Hool.

Absent: Councilpersons Hoppough and Schuliet; and City Manager Bosanic.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Moss supported. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held November 15, 2011.
2. Approval of payroll report for pay period ending November 13, 2011 in the amount of \$127,212.43 and the special pay period ending November 30, 2011 in the amount of \$41,417.52. Approval of accounts payable for period ending November 23, 2011, in the amount of \$172,718.08
3. Approval of minutes for the regular DDA meeting held October 11, 2011.

A public hearing was held to receive comment on an existing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in connection with Uni-Solar. No action was taken.

Council revisited the tabled item considering a request for license to use public property to install and use a boat dock on Baldwin Lake.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To deny the request to grant a license for use of City property for a boat dock as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The City Council is open to granting a license for a boat dock if and when the subject property is developed with a structure that contains a permitted use under current zoning. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council received a presentation from Dr. Kim Singh, Mid-Michigan Health Department Director in connection with area health assessment.

Council considered the approval of request to sell alcohol at a Federal Facility in the City of Greenville.

Councilperson Scoby MOVED: To approve the request from the Michigan Promoters Association to allow alcohol sales at a Federal Facility for a one day event to be held on December 17, 2011 as presented. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a resolution designating City officials to enforce the City of Greenville Zoning Ordinance. Councilperson Lehman RESOLVED: WHEREAS, Section 22.01 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Greenville provides that the provisions of the Ordinance shall be administered by the Zoning Administrator, or such other official or officials as may be designated by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, by prior resolution the Director of Public Safety and the City of Greenville's Public Safety Officers have been authorized to administer and enforce the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Greenville and have the same powers as the Zoning Administrator outlined in Section 22.01; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.6 of the City Charter of the City of Greenville states in part: "All administrative officers of the City, except the City Manager and Attorney, shall be appointed by the City Manager for an indefinite period, subject to confirmation by the Council." ; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has appointed the following individuals as administrative officers authorized to administer and enforce the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Greenville:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: Those above cited individuals are confirmed by the Council as the City of Greenville administrative officers with the same powers as the Zoning Administrator outlined in Section 22.01. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered approval of 20% match to a Federal Grant to purchase portable radios for the City of Greenville.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the purchase of 4 portable emergency radios using funds from the General Fund Balance as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe supported. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of a tow rope for Tower Mountain.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of a tow rope for the Tower Mountain tow rope operation to Unicord Inc. of Calumet Park IL. in the amount not to exceed \$1,950 as presented. Councilperson Scoby supported. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Lehman supported. Unanimously adopted.
