

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Moss, Schuleit, Lehman and Greene; City Manager Bosanic; Deputy Clerk Hatfield; Public Safety Director Reiss.

Absent: Scoby.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held December 1, 2015.
2. Approval of payroll report for regular pay period ending November 20, 2015 in the amount of \$115,564.30 and regular pay period ending December 4, 2015 in the amount of \$128,655.48. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending December 10, 2015 in the amount of \$1,421,878.05.
3. Approval of the minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held November 10, 2015.

Council received a report from the auditors on the 2014-2015 fiscal audit.

Council considered the approval of Contract 2015-0397 with the Michigan Department of Transportation in connection with the Greenville Municipal Airport.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the proposed contract No. 2015-0397 for snow removal equipment for the Greenville Municipal Airport in the amount not to exceed \$187,000 with the Michigan Department of Transportation as presented and authorized Mayor John Hoppough to sign all of the contract documents.

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation has received a block grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for airport development projects; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of snow removal equipment and carrier vehicle with attachments pertaining to construction is eligible for federal funding under the federal Airport Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires acquire the aforementioned equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation has submitted a contract for City consideration setting the terms for funding and cost for participating item.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the City of Greenville approves the contract with the Michigan Department of Transportation for the acquisition of snow removal equipment and carrier vehicle with attachments pertaining to construction. Said contract having been assigned the number 15-0397, and authorizes the Mayor to sign the contract document on behalf of the City.

Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the removal of snow and ice on City sidewalks.

Councilperson Lehman: To award a bid for the snow and/or ice removal of city sidewalks in accordance with local ordinance violations to Greenville Lawn Care, Inc. of Greenville, Michigan in the amount not to exceed:

66 feet - \$30 per cleaning

132 feet - \$55 per cleaning

Longer - \$45 per hour

As presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of the 2016 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Councilperson Lehman Moved: To adopt the proposed Federal Guidelines and Maximum Asset Standards as presented. Councilperson Greene seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a bid to purchase laptop computers for the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of 5 laptop computers for the Public Safety Department to MNJ Technologies of Buffalo Grove, Ill in the amount not to exceed \$6,200 as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.
