CITY OF GREENVILLE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR MICHIGAN
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING FOR
GREENVILLE IMPROVEMENTS TO WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND
TREATMENT FACILITIES PROJECT

The City of Greenville will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, April 4, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenville City Council Chambers, 415 S. Lafayette St., Greenville, Michigan 48838 for the purpose of affording citizens an opportunity to examine and submit comments on the proposed application for a CDBG grant.

The City of Greenville proposes to request \$1,296,000 in CDBG funds for the “Greenville Improvements to Wastewater Collection and Treatment Facilities” Project. The Project will include construction of a Septage Receiving Facility at the Greenville Wastewater Treatment Plant and replacement of the Judd Street Lift Station. The Project will benefit all City rate payers by creating a new revenue source and completing needed repairs without rate increases to them thereby benefitting Greenville’s 60.4% low to moderate income persons without any displacement. It will also benefit those in the region through creating a local site for septage disposal.
