

DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY

The City of Greenville, located 35 miles northeast of Grand Rapids, Michigan, in Montcalm County, is seeking a Director of Public Safety to manage its full-time Public Safety Department. Salary range is \$72,000 - \$82,000, DOQ.

An Associate Degree in criminal justice, business or related field, five years experience in police supervisory work with increasing administrative responsibility, valid Michigan driver's license, and current MCOLES certification are required. Additional training from the FBI Academy Staff and Command School, and a Master's or Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice are highly desirable.

The City of Greenville is seeking an individual with proven skills in managing a police or a Public Safety department. The successful candidate must possess strong leadership skills, knowledge and experience in modern police administration/practices and the investigation and prevention of crime, progressive command experience, collaborative management style, excellent communication skills, experience in labor/management relations, be fiscally responsible with extensive knowledge of budget preparation and control, be certified as a Public Safety Officer Level 1 fire fighter or be willing to become certified, and enjoy working with the general public.

Greenville operates under the Council-Manager form of government with the Director of Public Safety reporting to the City Manager. The Department of Public Safety consists of: 15 full-time fully cross trained public safety officers, a Deputy Director, 21 part-paid firefighters, and 3 full time civilian administrative staff. The FY-2016-2017 Department of Public Safety budget is \$1.5 million.
