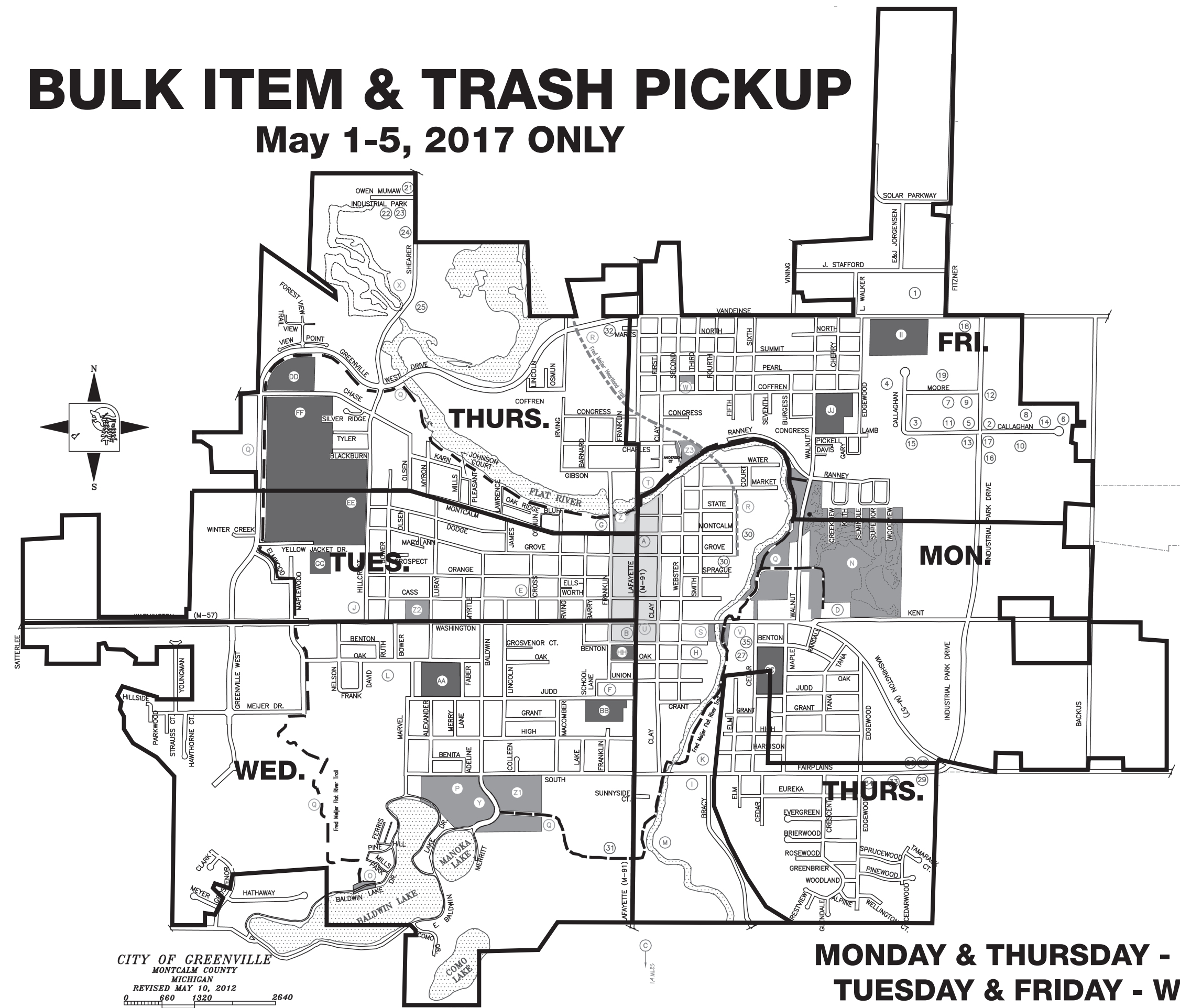
SEE ATTACHED MAP FOR PICK UP DAY IN YOUR AREA

Allied Waste of Michigan will be providing bulk item pick-up for the residents of Greenville. Pick-up at your residence will be the day indicated on the map titled "Bulk Item & Trash Pick-up". After the bulk item week is through, regular trash pickup will resume on Wednesdays.

- The regular trash pick-up will also occur along with your bulk item collection date for the week of **May 1-5, 2017**.
- This service is offered free of charge to Greenville Residents Only (Homeowners violating this provision will be prosecuted).
- Place bulk items such as sofas, chairs, dressers, stoves, refrigerators, water heaters, carpet rolls, old play sets at the curb on the scheduled pick up day by 6:00 am, but no sooner than 24 hours in advance.
- Refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners must be completely drained of Freon by a certified technician and must have a certified sticker indicating so.
- **UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: BUILDING MATERIALS AND HAZARDOUS WASTE (TIRES, PAINTS, CHEMICALS, ETC.) WILL NOT BE PICKED UP AS THEY ARE PROHIBITED FROM BEING PLACED IN LANDFILLS BY STATE LAW.**
- NO ITEMS WEIGHING OVER 90 LBS. WILL BE PICKED UP.

City of Greenville residents will be able to drop off, bagged or not bagged, leaves/ grass clippings, and brush (no stumps) at the City Compost Site.

Please keep any and all types of trash from yard waste.

The Compost Site is for City of Greenville Residents Only: You must produce a valid driver's license for proof of residency to the on-site attendant.

Residents unable to haul yard waste themselves may solicit the services of lawn care companies. If using a company to deliver yard waste, a photocopy or cell phone photo of the owner's driver's license must be shown to the on-site attendant.

NOTE: Bagged leaves and grass clippings must be in biodegradable paper yard waste bags only. No plastic allowed.

NOTE: Any yard waste placed at the curb or into the street will be considered a violation and will be removed at the owner's expense.

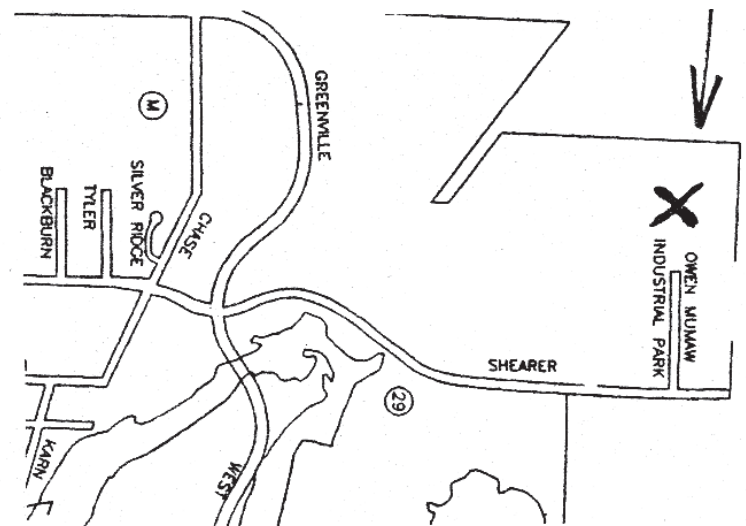
Compost site: 1150 Owen Mumaw Dr. - west off Shearer Rd. (see map below)

Also: The City has HIGH Quality screened compost top soil for sale at the drop site.

\$13.50 plus tax per yard, we load.

Purchase top soil from City Hall before you arrive at the drop site, show your receipt to the attendant.

Some Important Ordinances to be aware of this time of year...

Please be advised that city residents are responsible for the timely upkeep and maintenance of their lawns. Any growth of grass or weeds over 8 inches in height is in violation of city ordinances and will result in mowing, fees and/or ticketing.

Please remember that your Allied Waste refuse cart cannot be placed at the curb earlier than 24 hours before the scheduled pickup (Wednesdays), and must be removed from the curb no later than 24 hours following pickup.

At no other time, except BULK ITEM WEEK, can any other items be placed by the curb. Any items placed at the curb will be considered littering and the City will remove the item(s) resulting in removal and disposal fees to the homeowner/resident.

No signs advertising a garage sale or a yard sale shall be placed on public property, utility poles or on private property except for the property on which the garage sale or yard sale is conducted. Within 24 hours after the conclusion of a garage sale or a yard sale, all signs shall be removed.

Failure to comply with these ordinances may result in civil infraction ticket being issued for each offense.
